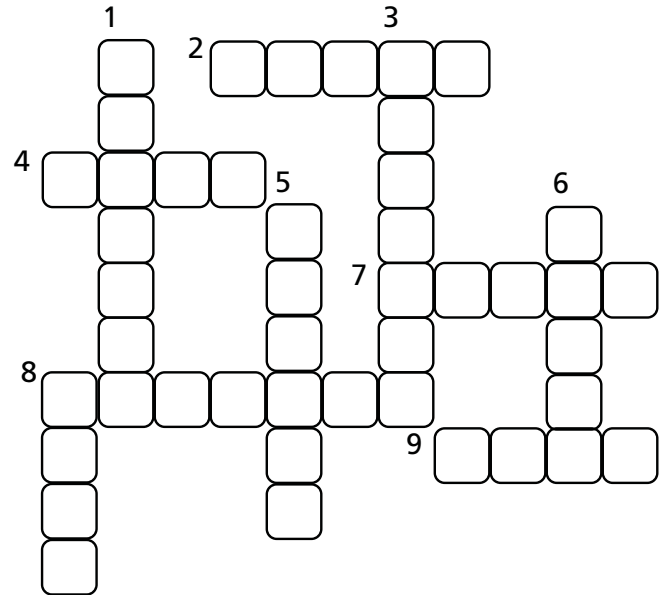

### ACROSS

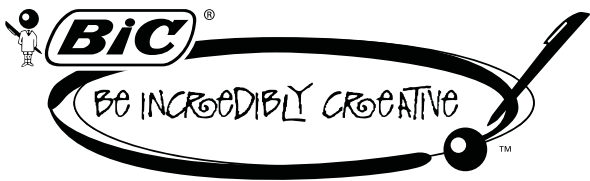
- 2. A group of students is called this; also, where you sit is called a \_\_\_\_ room.

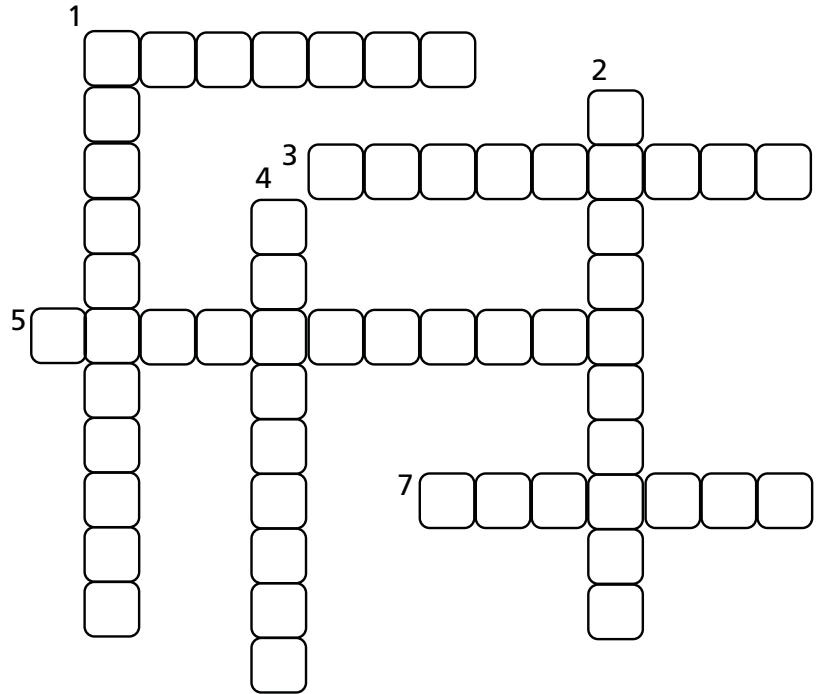

### ACROSS

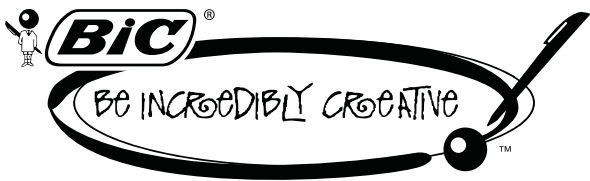
- 1. This treat is heated up, and doesn't come "on the cob."
- 3. You chew this, but don't step on it or get it in your hair. You can blow bubbles with it.
- 5. Also sometimes called "candy floss," this wispy treat is usually pink or blue, and made of pure sugar.
- 7. This sticky substance can be eaten by itself, or in a cake, or covering an apple.

### DOWN

- 1. These crispy items come in bags, and in flavours like regular, salt and vinegar, barbecue, and many more.
- 2. These small items come in many different colours and flavours. Black ones taste like licorice.

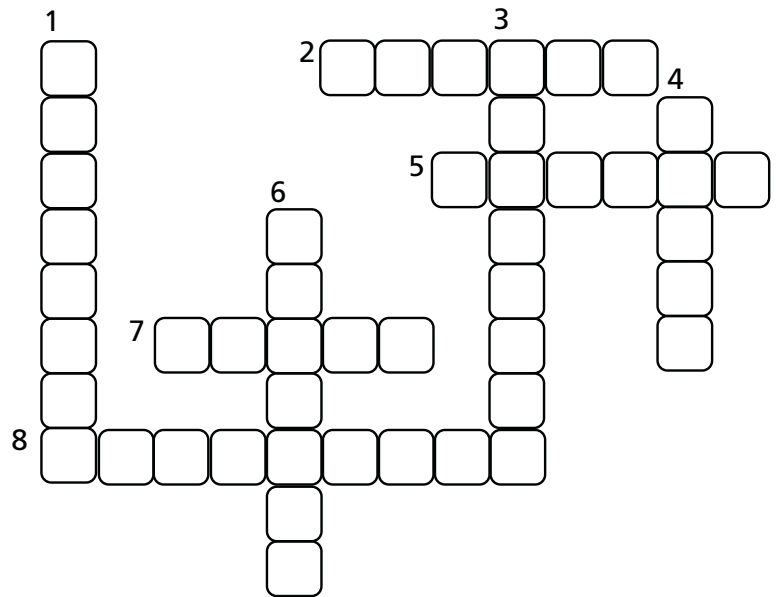


## MUSIC

Music is made by a variety of instruments. A person tapping her finger on a desk is the most basic, right through a 50-piece orchestra. In this crossword, read the clues and figure out the names of the instruments.

### ACROSS

- 2. This stringed instrument has a neck, and you strum it with one hand. It comes in regular and electric versions.
- 5. With this small instrument, you tuck one end between your chin and shoulder, hold the other end with one hand, and draw a bow across the strings.
- 7. These are a percussion instrument. You can beat it with your hands or with sticks. One famous type are the bongos.
- 8. You blow into one end of this wind instrument. Oh, here's a hint: It was invented by a man named Sax.

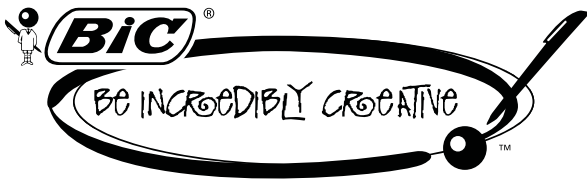


### DOWN

- 1. These wind instruments are popular in Scotland and Ireland, but some critics say that they sound like a cat being injured.
- 3. Here's a very simple instrument. You simply tap a little stick against it. Its shape is also its name.
- 4. One of the most widely-played instruments, you play it by pressing down keys, and stepping on pedals.
- 6. This brass instrument is similar to the bugle, trombone or tuba, except smaller and the source of a higher-pitched sound. It is often used in military bands.

## FOOD

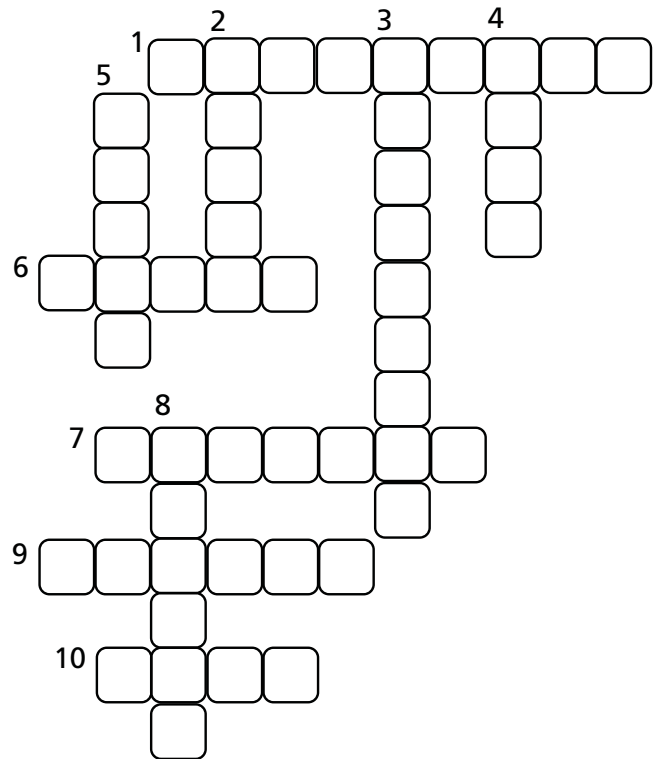
Everybody loves good food. However, each of us have a different favourite type of meal. In the crossword, there are types of food — maybe even your own personal favourite.

### ACROSS

1. This Italian food is like long strings. It is often served with meatballs.
6. This dish includes lettuce, with some fruits or nuts added, and often topped with a dressing like 1,000 Island or French.
7. Meat from this white bird is served as "fingers," "wings," in a sandwich, or just on its own.
9. This vegetable can be mashed, boiled, or cut up and served as french fries.
10. Meat from a pig is called this.

### DOWN

2. This popular food is often delivered to homes. It is Italian, comes in slices, topped with pepperoni, mushrooms, and just about anything else.
3. Stick a patty of meat into a bun and you have this. Often topped with ketchup.

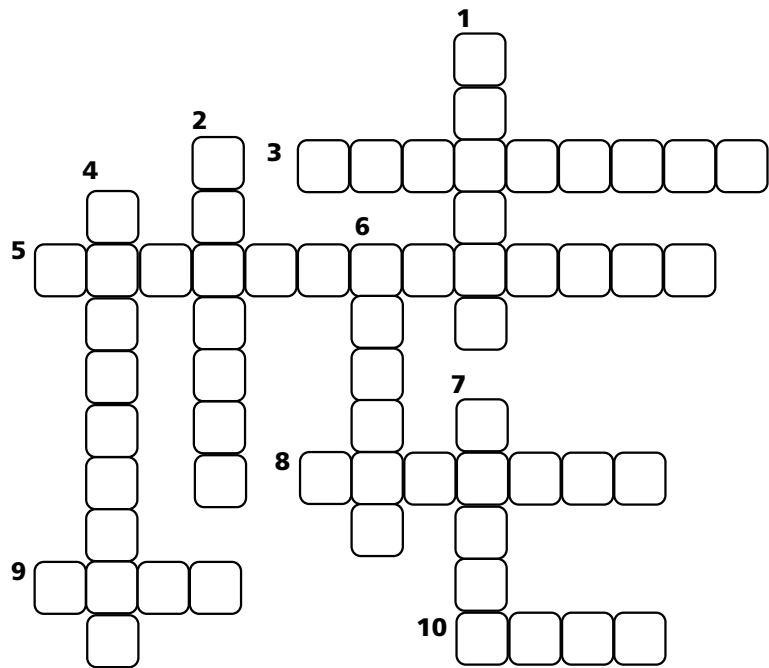

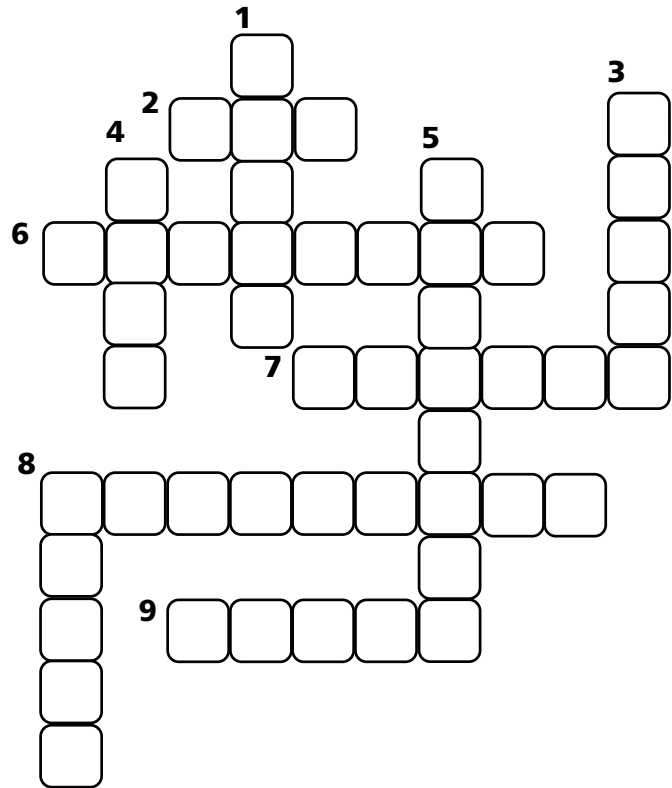
