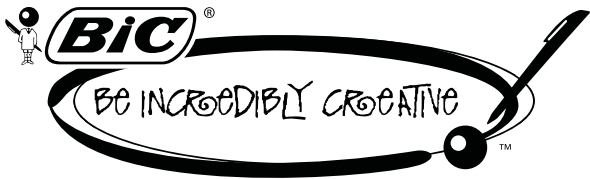

MUSIC

Music comes in a wide variety of different styles, and a single song can even be a mix of two or more styles. Below, we've scrambled the names of some of the most popular styles... how many do you know?

1. This style was born in the inner cities of the United States, in the mid- to late '70s. It is also sometimes called "hip hop."

PAR

2. In the late '40s and early '50s, this style grew in popularity thanks to radio DJs, and soon kids and teenagers around the world were dancing to its fast beat.

RKCO

3. Artists of this style usually have long hair, and wear jeans and chains and sing so loud they're almost shouting. Often, people listening to it will slam their hands back and forth in time with the music.

MTLEA

4. In this style, a lot of the music comes from brass instruments, particularly the saxophone. There are often week-long festivals in major cities dedicated to this style.

JZAZ

5. Picture a singer carrying a guitar and wearing a cowboy hat, and you've got the stereotyped example of an artist in this style. Sometimes referred to as "_____ and Western."

CYRTUNO

6. Most of this style is sung in German or Italian, and usually involves a storyline. Luciano Pavarotti is a famous example of a singer of this style.

OAREP

7. There's no singing in this style, just instruments, very often violins and pianos. Composers like Mozart and Beethoven worked in this style from the 1500s through the early 1900s.

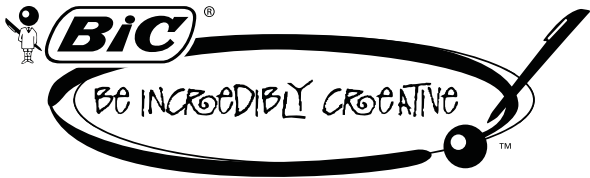
8. This fruit comes in bunches, sometimes with seed, sometimes without. You may have to pick them off a stem. It also becomes a popular flavour of juice.

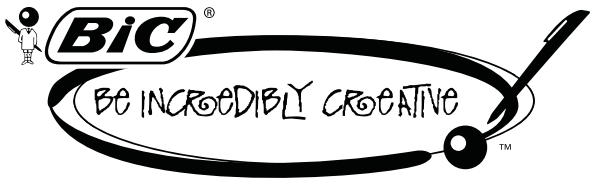
